All money raised will be put back into the youth programs in the Hereford and Timonium communities.

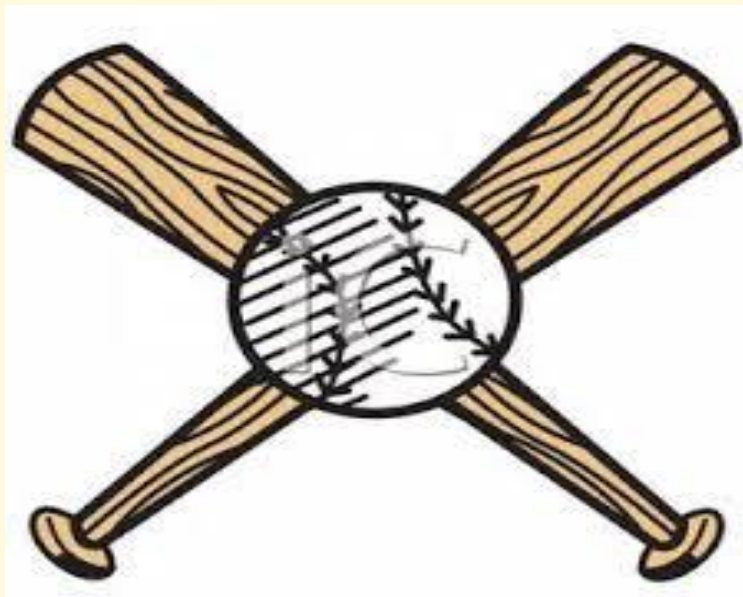
Some of the youth programs that we sponsor are Youth Appreciation Week, Essay contest, Oratorical contest, and Scholarships to High School Students.
